

House conversion and refurbishment

Key points

Architectural project - small works.

- Large terraced house previously converted to flats
- Replacement windows and reconstruction to rear
- New borrowed light through bathroom to staircase
- Major works to master bedroom and bathroom
- High specification works

I was commissioned to convert a house previously in multi-occupation back to a single family dwelling. The semi-detached late Victorian house had well proportioned rooms but lacked modern facilities. It also had a very dark staircase. Key moves were to link the master bedroom to a long spacious bathroom giving borrowed light from the side elevation through the bathroom to the staircase with glass bricks set in the staircase partition wall. A new bathroom was also provided on the top floor for the au pair and child's bedroom.
