I was commissioned to add space and create an extra room for a private client in a small garden flat in Camden Town. The flat had a lovely garden but the spaces outside the flat did not do justice to its quality.

By simply infilling a patio space with a new room and rooflight, a much improved interior with a new living space was created. More and better quality space was created for the kitchen and the second bedroom was directly accessible from the main living area with its own en suite bathroom. All from filling in an outside space.
